Suggested Abstract Format

We recommend including the following sections, although we also note that there are often good reasons to deviate from this format. In each section, answer the question listed below

INTRODUCTION: "Why was this study/research performed? What unsolved problem are you addressing?"

METHODS: "How did you study this problem?"

RESULTS: "Report the data, analyses and/or outcomes"

DISCUSSION: "How do you interpret the results?"

CONCLUSION: "What is the relevance to clinical practice or future research?"

REFERENCES: References should use the suggested style below.

Word Limits: The following word limits will apply:

Title: 125 characters **Body of the Abstract:** 750 words (references not included)

Measurements: Each presenter will be allotted a poster space of 91.44 Centimeters or 36 inches Width X 91.44 Centimeters or 36 inches Height Please note the allotted size and be attentive not to exceed these dimensions.

During Your Session: Poster authors are required to be present, at their posters, during the Poster Walking Tour Reception to discuss their poster with attendees and answer any questions.

- The poster should show the full title of your abstract.
- Text should be brief and well organized, presenting only enough data to support your conclusions.
- The text should make clear the significance of your research.
- The text should include the categories indicated by the focus of your poster, clinical or research, as outlined in the abstract submission instructions.
- Include all references. Design
- A clear, simple, uncluttered arrangement is the most attractive and the easiest to read. The title lettering should be approximately 5cm (2 in.) high, with authors' names and affiliations in smaller print.
